Piruatigiit Ikajuqtiit – Child & Youth Worker

1 Year Term with possibility for extension • Iqaluit, Nunavut

Some duties will include:

- Program development and delivery grounded in Inuit Qaujimajatuqangit geared toward children and youth with suspected/confirmed FASD as well as to siblings and 'friends of friends' with FASD
- Deliver Piruatigiit FASD presentations with team to other interested organizations and systems
- Provide information and resources developed by our centre as well as other FASD literature to individuals and families making inquiries to Piruatigiit
- Help create links with other services and resources locally, territorially and federally for individuals and families

Highly valued experience:

- Experience working with children & youth who have suspected/confirmed FASD
- Experience working with the public in the human services field who may be experiencing oppression, marginalization, and multiple difficulties
- Experience providing support and programming from a person-centred, strengths-based, trauma informed approach
- Experience taking client notes and maintaining confidential records
- Proficiency in the Inuktitut/Inuktut language – spoken and written proficiency is highly valued, as we aim to provide all of our programs and resources in Inuktitut/Inuktut
- A certificate, diploma or degree in a related field: social work, counselling, mental health, addictions counselling, etc.
- Knowledge of Inuit Qaujimajatuqangit, the Nunavut Agreement and the TRC Calls to Action (in particular #33 & #34)

**A combination of education, professional and lived experience will be considered for the position of Piruatigiit Ikajuqtiit/Child and Youth Worker position.*

This position does not come with staff housing. Must have lived in Nunavut for a minimum of 3 years.
