Workforce Development Coordinator

Therapeutic Programming Director

Provide leadership in the development, delivery, and continuous improvement of therapeutic and clinical programming. This senior management role oversees addictions and trauma treatment services, promotes clinical excellence, supports staff wellness, and ensures culturally relevant, trauma-informed care for Inuit.

House & Facilities Manager

Lead a multidisciplinary team responsible for housekeeping, maintenance, groundskeeping, and other operational services. This role is essential to ensuring Aqqusariaq maintains a safe, welcoming, functional, and healing environment that supports recovery from addictions and trauma.
