



REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS LEGAL SERVICES FOR THE NUNAVUT WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT BOARD

The Nunavut Wildlife Management Board (NWMB or Board) is seeking proposals from qualified legal professionals or qualified legal firms to provide legal services for the NWMB. More details of the Request-for-Proposals can be obtained from the NWMB.

The NWMB, established in 1993 pursuant to the terms of the Nunavut Agreement, is an institution of public government mandated to serve as the central body responsible for wildlife management within the Nunavut Settlement Area. The Board routinely makes wildlife management decisions that are complex and oftentimes controversial.

The qualified legal professional or firm will need to be able to demonstrate, but may not be limited to, the following:

- Familiarity of the Nunavut Agreement relevant to the NWMB;
- Familiarity of Territorial, Provincial, Federal and other Land Claim wildlife statutes;
- Legal policy analysis of Territorial, Provincial, Government and other Land Claims wildlife statutes, policies and procedures;
- Legal policy development of NWMB Policies and Procedures;
- On-site legal services during the Board's face-to-face meetings and teleconferences;
- Advising and assisting with Administrative Law;
- General legal advice, including written legal opinions, reviews and advice on documents, contract and agreements;
- Ability to provide legal services under very tight timelines;
- Ability to provide cost effective legal advice on a timely basis;
- Court and/or Tribunal representation.

The proposal will need to be limited to 15 pages in length (Arial 12pt font).
