



# KATIVIK REGIONAL GOVERNMENT PUBLIC NOTICE

## Adoption of the certified fire safety cover plan (FSCP) for Nunavik

**Public notice is given by the undersigned:**

**Whereas** the KRG has proceeded with a revision of the FSCP for Nunavik including an implementation plan for the Kativik Regional Government (KRG) and the NVs;

**Whereas** pursuant to Resolution 2018-350 adopted by the Executive Committee on August 28, 2018, the KRG has approved the above-mentioned revised draft FSCP;

**Whereas** in accordance with Section 20 of the *Fire Safety Act*, the revised draft FSCP was submitted to the Minister of Public Security (Minister), along with every other required documents, for issuance of a certificate of compliance;

**Whereas** pursuant to Sections 21 and 22 of the *Fire Safety Act*, the Minister proposed minor amendments to the above-mentioned revised draft FSC. These amendments were adopted by the KRG;

**Whereas** a certificate of compliance has been issued by the Minister on May 16, 2019;

**Whereas** pursuant to Section 23 of the *Fire Safety Act*, the KRG adopted the revised certified FSCP on May 29, 2019;

**Whereas** the FSCP applies to the following municipalities on the territory of the Nunavik: Kangiqsualujjuaq, Kuujjuaq, Tasiuaq, Aupaluk, Kangirsuk, Quaqaq, Kangiqsujuaq, Salluit, Ivujivik, Akulivik, Puvirnituaq, Inukjuak, Umiujaq and Kuujjuaraapik;

**Whereas** the earliest possible date of publication of the above-mentioned public notice in the Nunatsiaq News is June 7, 2019;

**Whereas** the KRG wishes to set the date of coming into force of the revised certified FSCP for Nunavik on June 25, 2019.
