- Assist Facilitator and learners by supporting hands-on learning opportunities through a coordinated placement position
- Networking with community-based organizations and divisions of government to better support learners' knowledge of existing resources
- Support participants in developing a graduation celebration following program completion

Highly valued experience:

- Previous work experience and demonstrated comprehensive knowledge of supporting people with FASD
- Demonstrated knowledge and understanding of caregiver and family needs and strengths
- Previous adult education/facilitation experience
- Awareness of universal design and inclusive teaching approaches to include learners with disabilities and learning differences
- Previous experience working with the public in the human services field who may be experiencing oppression, marginalization, and multiple difficulties
- Experience providing support and programming from a person-centred, strengths-based, trauma informed approach
- Proficiency in the Inuktitut/Inuktut language - spoken and written proficiency is highly valued as we aim to provide all of our programs and resources in Inuktitut/Inuktut
- A certificate, diploma or degree in a related field: education, social work, counselling, mental health, addictions counselling, etc.
- Knowledge of Inuit Qaujimajatuqangit Principles and Societal Values, cultural practices
- Comprehensive understanding of the history of the impact of colonization and forced change across Nunavut, along with respect for the resilience, cultural revitalization, and capacity of Nunavummiut
