Inuit Uqausinginnik Taiguusiliuqtiit Board is seeking individuals to serve as committee members for its Social Justice Terminology Committee, Committee on Educational Terminology, Committee of Environmental Terminology, Health Terminology Committee, Committee on Legal Terminology and Orthography Committee.

The terminology committees will review recommendations and expression in the Inuit Language. Terminology committee members will also issue recommendations to the IUT board for approval. The committee members will be paid an honorarium in accordance with the Financial Administration Manual and all travel costs will be covered by IUT. The committees will meet face to face once a year and by teleconference as needed.

To be eligible for appointment, individuals must:

- Have excellent fluency in the Inuit Language;
- Have a high level of knowledge, either traditional or academic;
- Be familiar with more than one dialect; and
- Have the capacity to assist with making decision about the future of our language.

Individuals who are interested in joining the terminology committees are encouraged to submit their resume along with a letter of interest.
