



NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETINGS FOR AGNICO EAGLE'S "SALINE EFFLUENT DISCHARGE TO MARINE ENVIRONMENT" PROPOSAL

The Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) has scheduled a Community Roundtable and Pre-Hearing Conference on **February 11-13 2021**. The objective of the meetings is to further the NIRB's assessment of Agnico Eagle Mines Limited's "Saline Effluent Discharge to Marine Environment" project proposal, a proposed amendment to the approved Meliadine Gold Mine Project.

The meetings will be held in-person in Rankin Inlet in the Recreation Hall, as currently permitted under Public Health Orders. There are limits on the number of people who can gather in the venue at one time, but seats will be available for each session on a first come, first served basis for community members wishing to attend and participate.

Simultaneous interpretation will be provided.
