Chief Executive Officer

The Legal Services Board of Nunavut (LSB) is seeking a Chief Executive Officer to lead the territorial legal aid organization that is critical to the ongoing social, economic, and political fabric of Nunavut. LSB is responsible for providing legal aid services to financially eligible Nunavummiut in the areas of criminal, family, and civil law through regional clinics in Cambridge Bay, Rankin Inlet, and Iqaluit.

LSB is looking to appoint a CEO for a minimum initial term of three years, with a possible term of up to five years. Based in Rankin Inlet, the CEO is responsible for the organization's operations and management, supporting staff and liaising with the community and government. The CEO fosters strong relationships with stakeholders, internally and externally, particularly the public and Inuit population.

The successful candidate must be eligible to join the Nunavut Law Society and practice law in Nunavut. Candidates will bring broad-based knowledge of the judicial system, the legal aid system, and the private legal profession. Experience as a senior executive with financial and staff management is essential. The ideal candidate must have outstanding leadership capabilities and demonstrate an understanding of and sensitivity to Indigenous communities.
