The Kivalliq Inuit Association is looking for nominations to fill member positions for a three-year (3) term within the Nivvialik APMC.

The Nivvialik Area Co-Management Committee (APMC) is an advisory committee that is responsible for the day-to-day management of McConnell River Migratory Bird Sanctuary. The main job of the APMC is to make sure that wildlife and the habitat that wildlife depend on is conserve in those areas.

Minimum KIA Requirements:

- Must have interest, knowledge and/or experience in conservation, wildlife, tourism, and/or Inuit culture and heritage.
- Must be 18 years of age.
- Must have a criminal records check.

To be considered, candidates must be actively and personally committed to representing the interests of Nunavut beneficiaries.

Under the terms of the Umbrella Impact and Benefit Agreement for Territorial Parks in the Nunavut Settlement Area (Territorial Parks IIBA), Kivalliq Inuit Association (KIA) along with the Government of Nunavut (GN) appoints six (6) representatives to the Community Joint Planning and Management Committee.
